AIM Program Accelerated Industrial Maintenance Certificate

The AIM Certificate consists of three courses from Blackhawk Technical College: Mechanics of Learning, Safety (OSHA 30 General Industry Certificate), and Troubleshooting Integrated Manufacturing Systems 1 (TIMS). These one-credit courses offer a strong foundation of skills for individuals pursuing careers in manufacturing. Additionally, participants will have the chance to explore career opportunities in the field through job shadowing and career exploration at local manufacturing companies.
